

## **Conference Terms and Conditions**

*Cobalt Health Medical Charity*

### **1. General**

This conference (“the Event”) is organised by Cobalt Health Medical Charity (“the Organiser”) and held at the Elwes Building at the University of Gloucestershire, The Park Campus. The Event will take place indoors and comprises a programme of eight lectures, with scheduled refreshment breaks and a light buffet lunch. By registering or attending, delegates agree to these Terms and Conditions.

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### **2. Attendance and Donations**

Attendance at the Event is free of charge. Delegates are invited to make a voluntary charitable donation (suggested £25) to support Cobalt Health. Donations are entirely optional and are not a condition of attendance.

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### **3. Cancellations and Refunds**
